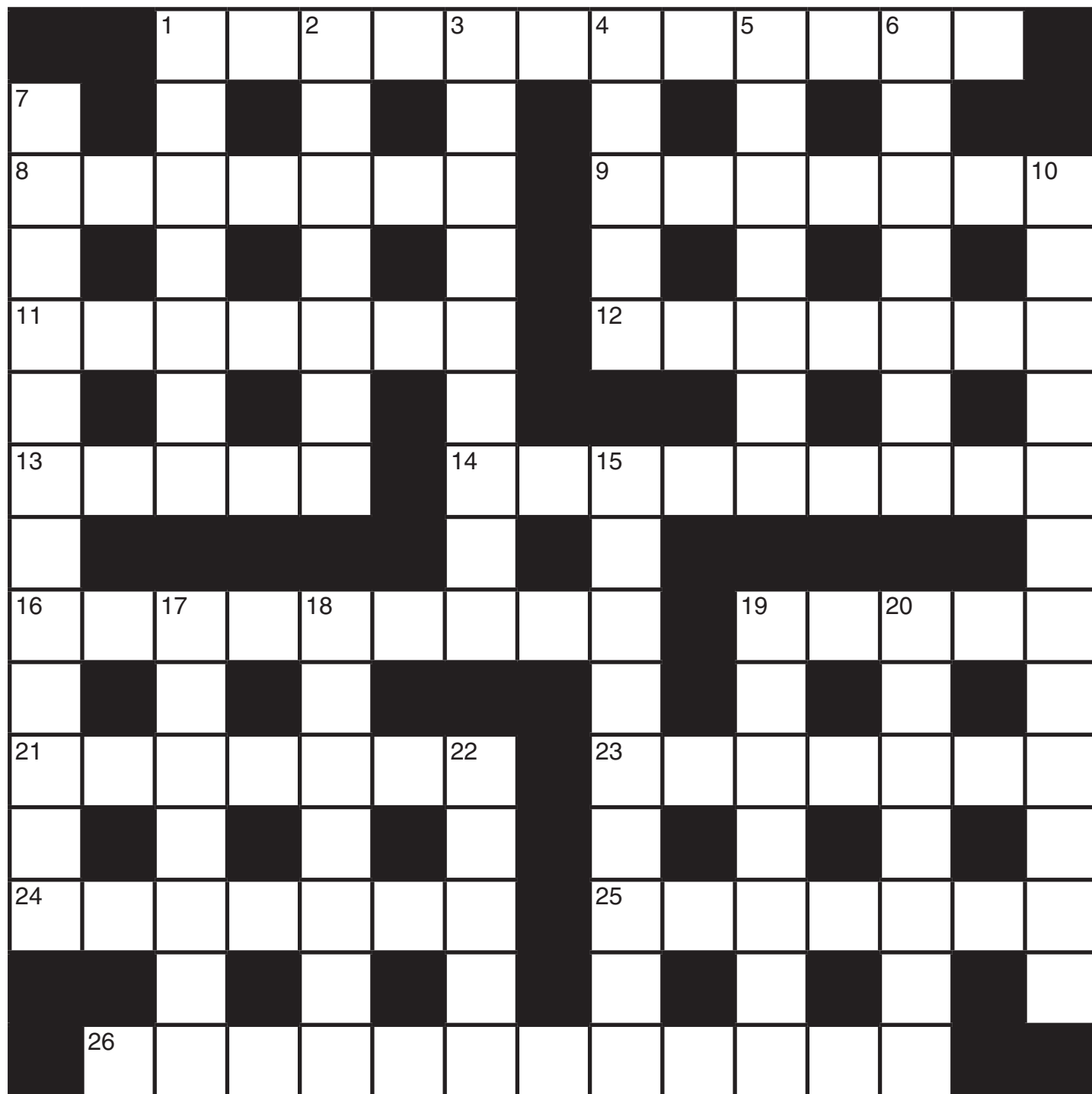


## Mungo's Crossword N026
