Welcome to the 11th Mullum Music Festival

Most self-respecting music tragics have a musical bucket list, acts they will travel halfway across the world to see. One of mine is coming to Mullumbimby this year!

Described by *The New York Times* as 'The Sultan of Shred', Bombino and his band will appear on Friday and Saturday. Also on the bill this year are Japanese kings of funk and soul Osaka Monaurail, much-loved reggae musician Mike Love (US), and Irish group Saint Sister, who NPR recently voted favourite discovery artists at SXSW 2018. All up more than 80 artists from around the world, the nation and locally grown, will descend on the small town of Mullumbimby for four days of captivating music.

New venues include the Byron School of Arts building, hosting an art exhibition and performances all days of the festival, Diner 55 replaces The Poinciana Café as our festival club; and Byron Shire Council will host an hilarious line up of stand up comedians in the Shire's Council Chambers on the Saturday and Sunday of the festival weekend. Also for 2018 we welcome the Ingenuity Sculpture Walk, and invite you all to take time out from the music and walk the path from the post office to Heritage Park.

The Mullum Music Festival is a wristbanded event. Wearing the official festival wristband provides access to all the official festival venues. We sell to the capacity of the combined venues, and we do



not oversell or crowd venues. It's inevitable that some gigs will be more popular than others, so please get to your 'must see' shows early to avoid disappointment, as venues do fill up. If a venue is full, then don't stress, there is always another great act just across the road, or next door, that will have space. Please respect the town and the neighbours of our venues, and at the end of the night, please leave venues quietly.

TICKETING Ticketing is at the Neighbourhood Centre next door to the Civic Hall on Dalley Street.

BUSES TO MULLUM A number of bus services will be running to and from the Festival. At the close of each festival day, a bus will depart from out the front of the Civic Hall, and will service Brunswick Heads as well as Byron Bay & Suffolk Park upon request. Cost is \$10 (Adult) & \$5 (Child) per trip.

MAGIC BUS Once again the ever-popular Magic Bus will be cruising the streets of our Festival in regular intervals to ferry festival-goers between venues and throughout the town. Cost: \$5 for a wrist band for the weekend or \$2 a ride.

PARKING The Festival takes place in Mullumbimby's existing venues. There is parking throughout the town. Please don't drive directly to ticketing to park; rather park when you first reach town and walk to ticketing.

It is a small town. There is parking available on Station Street if you turn left or right at the roundabout, at the Bowlo, at the High School, and behind the Ex-Services Club.

Please use these carparks, or park legally on the streets. Once parked you can stroll, ride your bikes, or use the Magic Bus to get around.

BUSKING As Mullum Music Festival is an artistically directed event, it's important your activities don't conflict with the already programmed events of the festival. Busking is permitted for holders of Byron Shire Council Busking Permits, and Council rangers are on hand to enforce Council's busking policy.

Busking Guidelines:

- All amplified busking must cease at 10pm and no amplified busking is allowed between the hours of 10pm and 8am. Non-amplified busking to end at 12am. No busking is to occur between 12am and 8am.
- No Busking on Dalley Steet, please, for festival weekend please busk only on Burringbar Street.
- Please do not busk in Festival designated areas, including the Civic Hall grounds, Festival Market Place or Civic Hall or Mullum High School precincts.
- Please no busking in side street off Burringbar Street.
- Where electrically amplified sound equipment is used, it must not be powered by mains power or generators. Only battery power from sealed (gel) or dry-cell batteries may be used.

Please only busk for 2-hour periods at a time. More info can be found at the festival website.

GARBAGE & NOISE

Please don't litter. There are extra bins provided throughout the Festival. As we are in transition to becoming plastic free, we encourage artists and festival-goers alike to bring their own non-plastic drink bottles, and make use of the water-refill stations throughout the Festival.

Please respect the town and residents of Mullumbimby and don't make excessive noise while travelling between venues.



Some artists not to be missed

KAIIT (PNG/AU)

At only 20 years old, Kaiit has shaken up the world of future-soul and RnB. She's been named in Red Bull Music's best rappers under 25, and claimed by Jill Scott as her and Erykah Badu's downunder love child. Kaiit is proving to be one of the most exciting artists to watch in 2018.

BOMBINO (AFR/NIGER)

'North African desert blues has become arguably the most successful world music genre to break through since reggae, and few have wielded the guitar with such mastery and majesty as Bombino' - Mike Rubin New York Times

Born in 1980 at a nomadic camp near this dusty outpost, the young

guitarist and songwriter Omara 'Bombino' Moctar was raised during an era of armed struggles for Tuareg independence and violent suppression by government forces. Bombino's electrifying jams capture the spirit of resistance and rebellion while echoing with guitar riffs reminiscent of fellow Africans Tinariwen and Ali Farka Touré, not to mention rock and blues icons such as Jimi Hendrix, John Lee Hooker and Jimmy Page.

OSAKA MONAURAIL (JAPAN)

With seven studio albums, two live albums and a solid reputation as a must-see act, Osaka Monaurail are Japan's premiere funk orchestra. They have been recording and touring together for more than 25 years and have built on their fanbase by thrilling audiences across Europe, Canada, USA, Asia, Australia and New Zealand for over a decade with their dynamic show. Expect to see a nine-piece band with sharp suits, organised steps, trumpets twirling in formation and the dynamic showmanship of charismatic singer and director Ryo Nakata. And expect to hear world-class, authentic, heavy funk.

TANGENTS

Tangents are an Australian-based quintet that melds electronic production, experimental rock and free improvisation. Comfortable working with jazz, folk music, post-rock and electronic music, their album *Stateless* was voted by *Treble* as one of the 10 Best Jazz Albums of 2016 which labelled it as 'an exercise in beat-laden serenity'. A Tangents live show is a natural extension of their recorded work - unique and unrepeatable, featuring an instinctual, organic sense of time an space, rhythm and melody between the five musicians.

GABRIELLA COHEN

Gabriella Cohen writes music that is emotionally raw, aching with nostalgia and painted with melodies that recall a languid lovesickness. The Melbourne via LA-based songwriter is known for her magnetic stage presence, captivating audiences with a combination of honest heartache and sinister sensuality.

BEN OTTEWELL (UK)

As a singer and lead guitarist in rock band Gomez, Ben Ottewell is well known for his unmistakable voice and talent for blistering and inspired guitar solos. *Rolling Stone* declared, 'Gomez's not-so-secret weapon is Ben Ottewell.' And as *GQ* magazine once wrote and anyone listening can attest, '[his] voice is not of this world.' 
